





Sandra Day O'Connor Sandra Day O'Connor was born in Texas in 1930. She and her family lived on a ranch. Sandra and her brother worked hard on the ranch. Sandra went to college. She got a law degree and she became a judge. She was a very important judge in Arizona. When Ronald Reagan became president, he made her a judge on the U.S. Supreme Court. Sandra Day O'Connor was the first woman to ever have this job. She began in 1981 and she stayed on the court for 24 years. Three other women have become Supreme Court Justices, but Sandra Day O'Connor was the first.
